SPIRITUAL PRACTICE Drawing

- → Imagine that you are looking out a window at your favourite tree. On the back of this page, draw what you see.
- → Imagine that the tree represents your life.
- → What are the 'fruit' of your life that others around you see? Write these on the tree.
- → Did you draw roots for your tree?
- → What keeps you connected to Christ, the source of all life?
- → Write these on the roots of your tree.

REFLECTION

→ Read Jeremiah 17:7-8

Blessed are those who trust in the Lord, who put their confidence in him. They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit.

- → How strong, deep and vital are your roots?
- → How are you connected to the life-giving stream of God's grace?
- → What are your life-giving networks or people who strengthen and encourage you and help you to grow in Jesus? Add them to your picture.
- → Are your roots holding steady? What might you need to do to strengthen these?

PRAYER POINTS

- → For all who are connected to The Salvation Army to go deeper in Christ.
- → For an openness to discover new ways to connect with God.
- → That the message of Jesus, the hope of the world, will be shared widely over the Easter period.

→ For protection for the young people and their leaders as they attend Easter Camps, and that they will encounter the Holy Spirit in a radical way.
