WRITING AN ODE TO JOY

Writing an ode is simply about tapping into the broadest reaches of you admiration for something. Describe your subject (in this case joy) inside and out. Exaggerate its admirable qualities until it seems to become central to human existence. Tap all five senses if you can, but don't force it. It is wonderful to directly address Joy in your ode. And ode speaks both to your feelings about it and describes its qualities. There are not real rules, an ode is just a freeform poem meant to express appreciation, so writing an ode to joy can be as literal or figurative as your temperament enjoys.

If it helps to not begin with a black page, here are some prompts.....

Writing Approach #1

Simply brainstorm the thoughts you have about joy and then arrange them in poem form as you would like. If it's helpful, here are a few prompts to get your brainstorming juices going:

- How does joy sound?
- Does joy have a taste?
- What is the size of joy?
- Where can it be found?
- What does joy look like?
- When is joy most present or what makes joy illusive?
- Who personifies joy to you?
- Does joy have a season?
- If you could speak to joy, what would you say?
- If joy could speak, what would you ask it?

The prompts to draw out your thoughts/feelings on joy are endless! Take it away!

Writing Approach #2

You can also approach writing an ode ad-lib style:
Joy, you are like (compare it to something else).
When you are with me, I feel (list multiple sensations).
You are &
I see you in(name people and groups who demonstrate joy to you).
I want to(what would you like to do with Joy).
To me you look like and taste like
One of my fondest memories of you is
It always surprises me that you show up when happens.
I love you because you fill the air with
When I'm old, I hope you & I and so(adjective) and so(adjective)
If I could, I would give you to(person or people) because your presence in their world would you are that powerful.
Joy, you(verb),verb andverb and I love you for it.

Examples of Odes

Oh Olive, You are as precious to me as any gem, With your beautiful, pure skin as smooth as silk and as green as the grass in summertime, I love your taste and the smell of your tender fruit which hides beneath your green armour. Oh Olive. Sweet, tasty Olive How I love you so and my mealtimes wouldn't be the same if you weren't in my life.

Oh, my beloved bed.

How I love to fall

Into you each night

After a stressful day.

You are still there

With open arms

And a welcoming smile.
